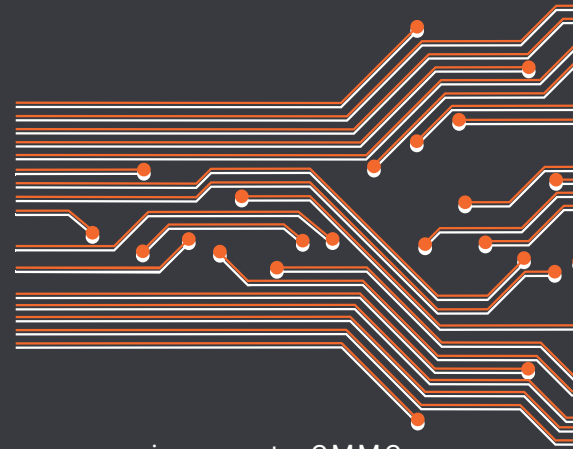


MICROSOFT 0365 LICENSE MAP

FAQS

WHAT DOES "FAT CLIENT" MEAN?

FAT Client alludes to applications, like Word, Excel, etc, being installed on a device. Unlike Webapps, customers are able to access the applications without opening an internet browser.

IS THERE A MINIMUM LICENSE COUNT?

There is no minimum license count.

CAN YOU MIX AND MATCH LICENSE TYPES?

Companies are allowed to purchase different types of Microsoft O365 Licenses. For example, if some employees only need Email and others need FAT Client abilities, the company could purchase both Exchange P1 and E3 licenses.

WHAT IS A TENANT?

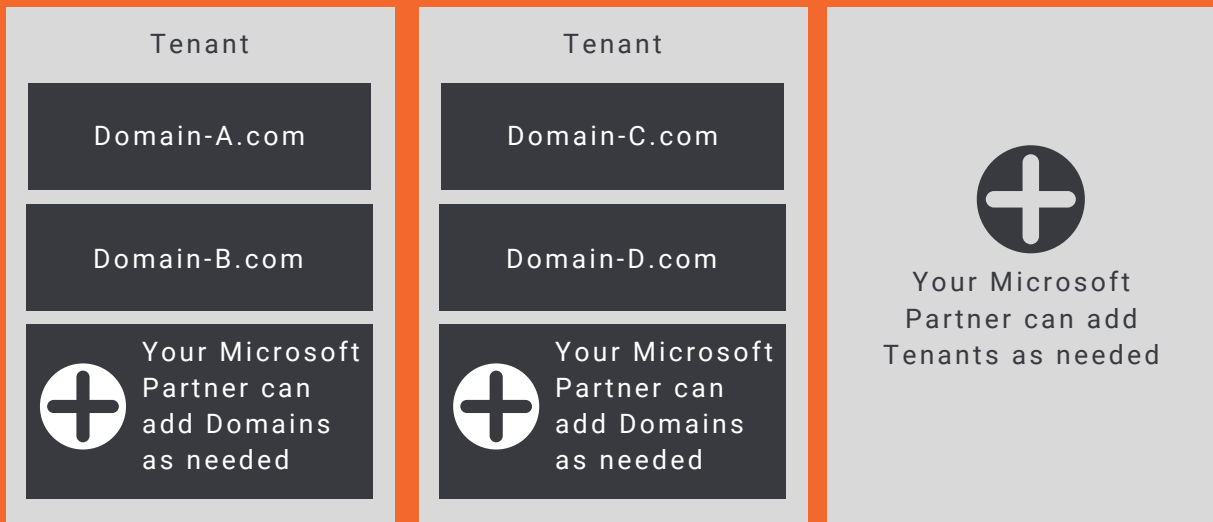
A tenant is a specific environment within O365 that a customer's licenses are bound to. Usually, a company will only have one tenant but it is possible to have multiple tenants. This is usually driven by organizational separation or differing compliance standards among groups. Additionally, the tenant serves as a dedicated instance of Azure Active Directory.

WHAT IS A DOMAIN?

A Microsoft Domain serves as a computer network in which all user accounts and devices are registered. Domains are housed within a tenant and cannot be created without a tenant.
